The grievance of the petitioner is that the amount of tax deducted by the Punjab State Power Corporation Limited and Punjab State Transmission Corporation Limited and deposited with the Excise and Taxation Department has not been refunded to the petitioner as on the entire payment made, tax was not payable.

Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions received from Ms. Chander Kanta, ETO-cum-DO, Patiala, submitted that in case the petitioner furnishes all the requisite documents, his assessments for the years in question will be framed by the Designated Officer within a period of two months and whatever amount is found refundable to the petitioner, the same shall be refunded within a period of two weeks thereafter.

In view of the fair stand taken by learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
