Petitioner seeks correction in the internal assessment marks in the subjects of Physics and Chemistry, on the basis of the letter addressed by the Principal (Annexure P2) of respondent No.3-school.

The stand taken by respondent No.3, now, is that the petitioner has secured 21 marks each out of 30 in both the subjects and certificates issued by the then Principal seemed not to be correct, as per the record of the school, photocopy of the same was attached as Annexure R3/1.

The stand of the respondent-Board, on the other hand, was that the correction could not be done after the result had been declared and details of the marks had been sent by the school, at the initial stage, in November, 2015, which had been appended as Annexure R2/1, showing that the marks were 21 in both the subjects, in the internal assessment.

No replication has been filed by the petitioner, nor there is any representation on his behalf. Same was the position on 12.08.2016.

Resultantly, keeping in view the above circumstances, the present writ petition is dismissed.
