Petitioner has prayed for a direction to respondent No. 2 to renew his passport bearing No. E7462820 which is alleged to have been expired on 15.02.2014.

After notice, the respondent has put in appearance and submitted that after checking the record of the office, it has been found that the petitioner has not even applied for renewal of his passport.

In view thereof, the prayer made by the petitioner in this case cannot be granted. Counsel for the petitioner, however, submits that he would now apply for the renewal of the passport. In case the petitioner applies for renewal of his passport to respondent No. 2 within 15 days of the passing of this order, respondent No. 2 shall consider his application in accordance with law and decide the same within a period of 15 days thereafter.
