It is undisputed between the parties that during the pendency of the present writ petition, respondent authorities have laid down pipe-line from point A to B, B to C and C to D, as shown in the site plan placed on record along with the report of Balwinder Singh Kullar, Divisional Canal Officer, Ferozepur-respondent No.5 and the same is available at page 74 of the paper book.

Learned counsel for the State submits that needful has been done by laying down the underground pipe-line, rendering the present writ petition as infructuous.
