Feeling aggrieved against the impugned order dated 3.6.2015 (Annexure P-8), passed by the Chief Canal Officer, Haryana-respondent No.1, whereby sanctioning of additional watercourse AB at the instance of the petitioner was declined, petitioner has approached this Court by way of present writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of Certiorari, for quashing the impugned order.
