Challenge in the instant petition is to the order dated 04.11.2008 (Annexure P-1) in terms of which the petitioner, who was serving as a Head Constable, has been dismissed from service. Further challenge is to the orders dated 07.04.2010 (Annexure P-2) and 22.10.2010 (Annexure P-3) whereby the Appellate and Revisional Authorities have affirmed the penalty imposed.

Counsel at the very outset prays for withdrawal of the petition with liberty to file the petition afresh with better particulars.

Prayer is allowed.

Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

It is clarified that grant of such liberty for filing the petition afresh would not be construed as if this Court has condoned the aspect of delay, if any.
