This petition is filed by the legal heirs of deceased Dinesh son of Mool Chand, who is alleged to have died because of electrocution.

On 04.2.2015, this Court had directed the respondents to pay an interim compensation of ₹50,000/- to the petitioners within four weeks and also directed the highest officers of the Corporation to consider release of ex-gratia payment depending upon the economic status of the family, which is appropriate.

Consequent there-upon, the respondents have deliberated and decided to award compensation of ₹7,47,600/- after deducting the amount of ₹50,000/- which was paid as an interim compensation.

In view thereof, it is observed that adequate compensation

has been ordered to be paid and hence the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pay the amount of ₹7,47,600/- to the petitioners immediately after completing the formalities.
