Counsel for the petitioner, during the course of hearing has admitted that the proper forum for the redressal of his grievance was the special court constituted under Section 153 of the Electricity Act, 2003. It is submitted that inadvertently, the petition was withdrawn in order to approach the proper forum.

Petitioner is now aggrieved against the order dated 14.03.2013 by which the amount has been increased by the respondents arbitrarily.

Be that as it may, the petitioner may, if so advised, avail his remedy under the statute instead of knocking the doors of this Court, invoking its extraordinary jurisdiction provided under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

Faced with this observation, counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the petition in order to avail his remedy in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
