Petitioner is currently serving on the post of DPE under the Haryana School Education Department.

Counsel would submit that the State Government has formulated a Teachers Transfer Policy dated 29.06.2016 (Annexure P-5) and as per such policy the schools of a particular district have been divided into various Zones i.e. Zones No.1 to 7. By virtue of the Transfer Policy, a teacher who has completed a tenure of 5 years in a particular Zone/school would be liable to be transferred out.

The short grievance raised in the present petition is that the necessary details to be posted online are inaccurate inasmuch as the school where the petitioner is currently posted i.e. Govt. Senior Secondary School, Raichandwala, Block Alewa, District Jind is being reflected as Zone-3 whereas the correct Zone is Zone-7. Apprehension raised in the instant

petition is that on account of such discrepancy in the website, the petitioner would be posted out.

Counsel has also referred to a memo dated 08.07.2016 (Annexure P-8) issued by the Distinct Education Officer, Jind and addressed to the Director, Secondary Education, Haryana and in terms of which this very anomaly and inaccuracy has been pointed out. Counsel submits that till date the necessary correction has not been carried out and which would result in the petitioner being transferred out and thereby to the detriment and prejudice of the petitioner.

Without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant petition with a direction to respondent No.3 to consider the grievance of the petitioner in the light of a representation dated 22.09.2016 (Annexure P-12) that is stated to have already been filed. Respondent No.2 is directed to take a final decision upon the same within a period for five days from the receipt of a copy of this order.

Petition is disposed of.
