Learned counsel for respondents No.1 to 3 has stated that the husband of the petitioner, who was working as a Bailiff in Sessions Division, Ludhiana, was retired on 31.12.2011 and an enquiry was pending against him. He had died on 25.08.2012 and as per the reply filed by respondents No.1 to 3, the enquiry proceedings were dropped against the petitioner and his entire payment pertaining to retiral benefits have been extended to his widow. The final payment of GPF was given on 11.07.2012 and pension has been released on 10.04.2014. She has further stated that the enquiry proceedings were dropped against the petitioner in the year 2013 and since, the necessary relief has been granted, so the present petition has become infructuous.

Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
