The petitioner has filed the present writ petition under Article 226 of the constitution of India for issuance of writ of mandamus directing the respondent No. 1 to take action against the respondent No. 2 for not complying with the Central Board of Secodary Education (CBSE) Affiliation bye-laws with regard to payment of retiral benefits and gratuity amount.

Brief facts of this case are that the petitioners claim that they are not paid the retiral/pensionary benefits as per the CBSE bye-laws.

It comes out that the petitioners have served the legal notice dated 22.08.2016 (*Annexure P-3*) to be decided by the respondent No. 2-Baba Gandha Singh Public School, Barnala. The short prayer of the petitioners at this stage is that respondent No. 2 may be directed to decide above mentioned legal notice dated 22.08.2016 within time bound manner.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents 2- Baba Gandha Singh Public School, Barnala to

decide the representation/legal notice of the petitioner within two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

However, if the petitioner has any grievance that respondent No. 2 is not complying with the bye-laws of CBSE, he is at liberty to make the representation to the CBSE in this regard and in case the alleged violation continues then he can approach this Court, if so advised.
