After arguing the case for some time, learned senior counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of the Court to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondent-Municipal Committee by moving an appropriate representation in pursuance to the communication dated 23.08.2016 (Annexure P-9), at the first instance.

Permission is granted.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty, as prayed for.

However, it is made clear that if the petitioner files appropriate reply pursuant to the communication dated 23.08.2016 (Annexure P-9), the competent authority shall consider the same and decide it, at an early date by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly in accordance with law but in any case within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of reply from the petitioner.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present writ petition stands disposed of.
