The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner will be satisfied, if the respondents are directed to decide the legal notice dated 17.8.2016 (Annexure-P-1).

In these circumstances, without issuing notice to the respondents, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to decide the legal notice dated 17.8.2016 (Annexure-P-1) within one month from the date of receipt of copy of this order and if the pension and gratuity is payable, release the same, failing which pass a speaking order, declining the same.
