This petition is filed by the Insurance Company in order to assail the validity of the award of the Permanent Lok Adalat, Kaithal, dated 12.12.2015.

Parents of Nisha filed an application without impleading her mother-in-law. When the petitioner came to know about this fact, they filed an application. It is also submitted that mother-in-law of Nisha had also filed a petition under Section 166 of the Motor Vehicles Act,1988 (for short,'the Act') before the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal,
