Two petitioners, namely, Shindo Devi and Jagwant Kaur are working as Agandwadi workers and have challenged the notification dated 15.09.2011 (**Annexure P-4**) whereby for recruitment to the post of Supervisor by way of promotion, the condition of upper age of 52 years has been prescribed, as both the petitioners are above 52 years of age.

Upon notice, a reply, contesting the claim, was filed.

At the time of hearing today, an additional affidavit on behalf of the State has been filed. It is stated that the case of both the petitioners for promotion in their respective quotas has been considered, and on account of their lower merit as per selection criteria they did not fall within the zone of the appointment as Supervisor by way of promotion.

In view of above, learned counsel for the petitioner concedes that the present petition has become infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
