Mr. Joginder Singh, General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Sonipat, who is present in the Court has stated that the impugned show cause notice has since been withdrawn.

It being so, the present petition has become infructuous. However, it is found that the impugned show cause notice was issued to the petitioner for withdrawing the monthly financial assistance, alleging that the driving licence of the deceased husband of the petitioner was found fake and that why he (deceased husband of the petitioner) should not be dismissed from service. Since, the show cause notice was apparently illegal, the petitioner was pushed to file the writ petition before this Court, therefore, the General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Sonipat is burdened with the costs of ₹10,000/- to be deposited in the Legal Services Committee of this Court.

However, at this stage, it has been brought to the notice of this Court that in place of the old notice, a fresh notice has been issued to the petitioner as to why on the basis of same facts, her monthly financial assistance be not withdrawn.

The General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Sonipat, who is present in the Court, has undertaken before this Court that the said notice also being contrary to law, will be withdrawn with immediate effect. However, in future, if any action is taken on the similar ground, the petitioner shall be at liberty to approach this Court.

Disposed of as infructuous.
