The Petitioner claims that he was engaged on Daily Wage basis on monthly salary against the post of *Safai Karamchari* (Sweeper) in the office of Tehsildar, Bathinda. However, his services without any rhyme or reason were illegally terminated on 31.10.2012.

It is conceded that there was neither any appointment order issued nor is there any termination order. It is also conceded that the petitioner had approached the Industrial Tribunal wherein the respondent had asserted that the petitioner had not completed 240 days in a Calendar year as also that the post had been filled up by appointing an employee on regular basis after following proper procedure.

After arguing for sometime and having failed to convince the court, learned Counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw

the present petition to seek his alternative in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
