Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioners have approached this Court, by way of instant writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of Mandamus.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioners submits that when petitioners were facing genuine threat perception, they moved application dated 23.9.2016 (Annexure P-12) before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran-respondent No.5 but the same is also pending decision. He further submits that petitioners will be satisfied in case the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran-respondent No.5 is directed to consider and decide their representation within a reasonable time. He also submits that petitioners are ready to bear expenses of security guard provided to them.

Having heard learned senior counsel for the petitioners and without expressing any opinion merits of the case, lest it should be prejudice the rights of either of the parties, the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran-respondent No.5 is directed to look into the matter, consider the threat perception raised by the petitioners in their representation dated 23.9.2016 (Annexure P-12) and pass an appropriate order thereon, at an early date, strictly in accordance with law, but in any case within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. It is also made clear that security/additional security shall be provided to the petitioners at their own expenses.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present petition stands disposed of.
