1. The petitioner has approached this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to hand over the physical possession of plot to him or in the alternative to allot another plot in view of policy relating to exchange of plot dated 18.02.2013.

2. In compliance to the order dated November 21, 2016, Sh. Vijay Kumar, Estate Officer, HUDA, Bahadurgarh is present in Court in-person and he has produced a copy of the possession certificate along with a letter dated December 02, 2016 as Annexures R-1 and R-2 respectively wherein it has been mentioned that the physical possession of Plot No.2804-P, Sector 9 of Urban Estate Bahadurgarh has been delivered to the petitioner. Annexures R-1 and R-2 are taken on record, subject to all just exceptions.

3. The aforesaid fact has not been disputed by learned
counsel for the petitioner and he states that in view thereof, the
present petition has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed
of as such.
