Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, fairly states that he does not intend to press this writ petition for the Writ of Certiorari, for the time being qua the impugned resolution dated 4.1.2016 (Annexure P-1), because it is pending consideration before the Deputy Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Ferozepur-respondent No.2. He further submits that the petitioner will be satisfied in case the Deputy Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Ferozepur-respondent No.2 is directed to consider and decide the petition moved on behalf of the petitioner vide Annexure P-9, within a reasonable time.
