Learned senior counsel for respondent no. 1 submits that there is an arbitration clause in the brochure, as well as, in the allotment letter. In view of this, petitioner states that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant writ petition with liberty to avail the remedy available to him in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty. In case, the petitioner invokes arbitration clause, the same shall be decided by the Arbitrator preferably within a period of six months from the date of filing of appropriate application before it.
