Heard learned counsel for the respondents. In continuation of the order dated 29.07.2016, learned counsel for the respondents submitted that the petitioner is not entitled to interest on Contributory Provident Fund for a sum of ₹ 10,74,356/-, which was released on 29.06.2011, for the reasons that on 29.10.2008 when the respondents prepared cheques and the same were to be handed over to the petitioner she refused to accept the cheques contending that the matter is sub judice before the Court. In view of above said submission and as it is evidence from the para No.12 of the writ petition, the interest is restricted to arrears of salary and leave encashment only.

In view of the above discussion, order of this Court passed in the present petition dated 29.7.2016 read with the present order,

petition stands disposed of.
