The petitioner is a Vocational Mistress and on refusal of her extension in Ex-India Leave, re-joined the department on 29.08.2014 awaiting posting orders. The posting orders were issued on 12.09.2014 (**Annexure P-3**), whereby the petitioner was permitted to join at her place of posting on 19.09.2014.

The grievance of the petitioner is that inspite of the order dated 06.02.2015 (**Annexure P-5**), passed by the Director, Education Department (Secondary Education), Punjab, treating the period from 29.08.2014 to 18.09.2014 as duty period, no salary for the said period has still been released.

At the time of arguments, learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that his client would be satisfied that if a direction is issued to the respondents to dispose of her representation dated 03.08.2016 (**Annexure**

P-10) within a time bound manner.

The prayer is reasonable and liable to be accepted.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of by directing the respondents/competent authority to decide the claim of the petitioner, as set out in the representation (**P-10**) within two months from the receipt of the certified copy of this order and in the next one month, released all the admissible dues. Failing which, the petitioner would be entitled to receive the interest at the rate of 9 % per annum on the outstanding dues, to be recovered from the guilty official concerned.

Disposed of in the above terms.
