The nature of prayer made for staying dispossession of the petitioners till the copy of the order is not available to the petitioners would not warrant any interference in exercise of our jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India. However, since a grievance has been made that the copy of the order has not been supplied, we would unhesitatingly exercise our jurisdiction under Article 227 to direct the competent authority to look into the grievance of the petitioners and take an appropriate action thereon as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of one week from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.
