Applicant seeks permission to place on record additional documents as Annexure P-10.

Application is allowed, as prayed for.

CM stands disposed of.

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The only submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner is that the issue before this Court in Civil Revision No. 783 of 2010 (Paradise Trend Setters Pvt. Ltd. Co. Vs. Shiv Dev Singh and another), was limited to the tenancy between the landlord and tenants. It had nothing to do with the complaint against the brother of the petitioner namely Sh. Sudhir Passi-respondent No.2 regarding misutilisation of funds provided by the petitioner to his brother for running his business of Paradise Trend Setters.

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If that is so, the appropriate remedy for the petitioner would lie only in seeking clarification in Civil Revision No. 783 of 2010, which was disposed of by this Court vide Annexure P-7. Petitioner would be at liberty to move an appropriate application seeking clarification, in accordance with law.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present writ petition stands disposed of.
