The sole direction sought in this petition is directed to respondent No.4 to complete the service book of the petitioner and decide his legal notice/representation dated September 1, 2016 (Annex P-2). Non-completion of the service book is adversely affecting the petitioner in many ways one of which has led to non-payment of salary upon transfer from one school to another in implementation of the Teacher Transfer Policy 2016. The petitioner is a Lecturer in Political Science who has approached this Court with a prayer that his service book be completed. If the petitioner is inconvenienced due to non-completion of the service book or its lack of remittance to the appropriate authority, then he should not be prejudiced.

Accordingly, a direction is issued to the respondents to complete the service book of the petitioner and make it upto-date and to transmit it to the place where it is required in such a way as to not cause any disturbance in the petitioner's career. The service book be completed forthwith.

With these directions, the petition stands disposed of.
