Anupinder Singh Grewal, J. (Oral) :

The petitioner, who is working as labourer on daily wages has sought a direction to the respondents to regularize his services in accordance with the policy dated 1.10.2003 as amended on 10.2.2004.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that although the petitioner is working for over 18 years, but he has not been considered for regularization by the respondents. He has also drawn my attention to the legal notice dated 4.11.2015 (Annexure P-4) sent to the respondents which has failed to evoke any response.

Issue notice to the respondents

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Rathi, Senior DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with direction to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the case of the petitioner in terms of the State Government's policy dated

1.10.2003 as amended on 10.2.2004, in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
