Dismissed as withdrawn with a liberty to file a civil suit to resolve disputed questions of fact of handing over and taking over charge between petitioner and one Shri Ranjit Singh, J.E. which led to a situation where the measurement books remained in the custody of the petitioner for considerable time after his retirement.

It is settled that disputed questions of fact cannot be resolved in summary writ jurisdiction and are best left to the Civil Court to be determined on evidence.
