RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (ORAL)

Feeling aggrieved against the impugned orders dated 07.07.2015 (Annexure P12) and 14.07.2016 (Annexure P-13), petitioner has approached this Court, by way of present writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari, for quashing the impugned orders.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, fairly states that keeping in view the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case, he does not intend to press this petition for a writ in the nature of certiorari at this stage, because the petitioner intends to file a civil suit, seeking the appropriate declaration from the learned Civil Court, so as to succeed to the estate of late Sh. Jaila Ram. However, he submits that till the petitioner files the civil suit and also seeks interim injunction restraining the private respondents as well as respondent Society from alienating, interest of late Sh. Jaila Ram in the

respondent Society, impugned orders may be kept in abeyance for a period of one month from today.

In view of the abovesaid fair statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, permission is granted. Writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty, as prayed for. However, having been found second prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner as a genuine one, it is ordered that the impugned orders dated 07.07.2015 (Annexure P-12) and 14.07.2016 (Annexure P-13) shall remain in abeyance for a period of one month from today.

Resultantly, with the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present writ petition stands disposed of.
