The petitioners are seeking a direction to the respondents to consider their claim for selection on the post of PGT (Post Graduate Teacher) by giving 5% relaxation in qualifying marks as they belong to Scheduled Caste and Physically Handicapped categories, in terms of the advertisement issued by the respondents on 28.6.2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No. 6 has represented to the respondents in this regard but no response has been received. He further states that he shall be satisfied if the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondents to consider and decide the representation sent by petitioner No.6.

Issue notice to the respondents.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Harish Rathi, Senior DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is directed to furnish three sets

of paper book to the learned State counsel in the course of the day.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with direction to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation of petitioner No. 6, in accordance with law, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
