Learned counsel for respondents No. 1 to 5 states that on account of the injunction order dated 25.3.2015 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Panchkula, which is in operation till date, only 75 % of the pension was released and that the remaining retiral benefits have also been released.

Learned counsel for respondent No.6 (Manju Rani) states that she had filed a suit before the lower Court and that out of 100% pension, 1/3rd should be released and not 1/3rd of the 75%. If it is so, respondent No.6 can always seek clarification from the lower Court, where she had filed the suit. So far as the present Court is concerned, all the other benefits have been released. As such, the present petition has become infructuous for the time being.

Let the matter regarding 1/3rd amount payable to the wife be decided by the Civil Court.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
