Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari thereby quashing the order dated 24.09.2015 (Annexure P-11) passed by respondent No.1.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

It is the case of the petitioner that the petitioner, who is a

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practising advocate, is a member of the District Bar Association, Kurukshetra. The petitioner was granted licence bearing No.P-2805-1999 to practise as an advocate. On a complaint against the petitioner, licence of the petitioner was suspended w.e.f. 24.09.2015 to 05.11.2015 vide impugned order dated 24.09.2015 (Annexure P-11).

Admittedly, the impugned order dated 24.09.2015 (Annexure P-11) has been passed at the back of the petitioner without affording any opportunity of hearing and in this manner, the petitioner has been condemned unheard. Being faced with this situation, learned counsel for the respondents state that respondent No.1 will pass the order afresh after giving opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.

In view of the above, the impugned order dated 24.09.2015 (Annexure P-11) is set aside and respondents are directed to pass the order afresh in accordance with law. Respondents will be at liberty to give fresh notice to the petitioner, who will also file reply to the same within 15 days thereafter.

Disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
