Present writ petition is directed against the impugned communication dated 29.09.2016 (Annexure P-19).

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

After going through the record of the case and hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court is of the considered opinion that petitioner has got no locus standi in the matter. It is not for this Court to see, as to which building is to be demolished and which is not to be demolished. It will be the exclusive domain of the administrative authorities to see, as per the existing condition of any particular building. Further, the impugned communication (Annexure P-19) issued by the Deputy Commissioner has not been found suffering from any patent illegality or perversity.

In view of the above, no case for interference has been made out.

Dismissed.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of the Court to withdraw the present writ petition. Although, the prayer has not

been found to be a fair one, yet in the interest of justice, it is accepted.

Permission is granted.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
