In the instant writ petition, the petitioner has sought for a direction to the respondents to accept his resignation and relieve him from the duty of Postal Assistant so as to enable him to join to the post of ETT Teacher in the Department of School Education, Punjab. The respondents have filed an affidavit supported by document. The respondents have taken a decision on the petitioner's application for resignation. The same has been rejected in view of serious allegations on the part of the petitioner relating to misappropriation of Government money. In view of decision dated 6.10.2016 by the respondents, petition do not survive for consideration.

Accordingly, petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
