In the instant writ petition, the petitioners have questioned the validity of the order dated 14.06.2016 passed by the Appellate Authority under the Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972-cum-Dy. Labour Commissioner, Punjab, Chandigarh. Respondent No. 1 filed an application before the Authority for payment of gratuity. The same was declined and consequently she has filed an appeal before the Appellate Authority under the payment of Gratuity Act, 1972. Appellate Authority has remanded back the matter to the Controlling Authority, Patiala to decide the respondent's application afresh. When the matter has been remanded back from Appellate Authority to Controlling Authority, Patiala, then how this writ petition is maintainable. Reserving liberty to the petitioners to participate in the process of Controlling Authority, Patiala while deciding the grievance of the respondent and whatever the contention arises in the present petition be placed before the Controlling Authority, Patiala.

With this liberty, petition stands dismissed.
