Pleadings on record would indicate that the petitioner is presently serving as Anganwari Worker in village Barna, Block Thanesar, District Kurukshetra under the aegis of Department of Women & Child Development, Haryana.

The instant petition is directed against a show cause notice dated 21.9.2016 (Annexure P-10) calling upon the petitioner to show cause as to why proceedings be not initiated against her for termination of her services on the ground that no reservation is permissible in favour of a candidate belonging to Special Backward Caste and which benefit had been afforded to the petitioner at the stage of her recruitment on the post.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner at length, I am of the considered view that no interference is called for, at this stage.

Concededly, the petitioner has responded to the show cause notice and has submitted reply dated 28.9.2016 (Annexure P-11). It goes without saying that all the grounds and submissions available to the petitioner as regards the issue in question have been raised by the petitioner in the reply submitted by him. The instant petition is clearly premature and

is founded on an apprehension that an adverse view would be taken against her.

The instant petition is, accordingly, disposed of as not maintainable, at this stage. It is, however, observed that before taking any final view in pursuance to the impugned show cause notice dated 21.9.2016 (Annexure P-10) the District Program Officer, Women & Child Development, Kurukshetra would be obligated to take into account the grounds and submissions raised by the petitioner in the reply dated 28.9.2016 (Annexure P-11).

Disposed of.
