Learned counsel for the petitioners after arguing the case for some time impugning the order dated 06.09.2016 (Annexure P-8) vide which the appeal filed by them was dismissed, submitted that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to approach the competent authority for sale of land to them in terms of the provisions of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 (as applicable to Haryana) and the policy framed by the Government in this regard.

Learned counsel further submitted that no doubt as per the revenue record there may be some encroachment, however, the fact is that the petitioner had constructed the house way back in the year 1960. 30 feet wide road is available. The passage is not being obstructed.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

In case, any application is filed for purchase of land within two

weeks from today, the same shall be considered and decided within three months thereafter.
