The grievance of the petitioners in the present petition is that they were appointed on compassionate ground after the death of their father and their services are not being regularized, whereas, services of similarly situated persons, who are juniors to the petitioners and were also appointed like the petitioners, have been regularized. The request of the petitioners has not been accepted in spite of giving representation dated 2.4.2016 (Annexure P-5).

Counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied in case the directions are issued by this Court to consider their representation at par with persons mentioned in para No. 14 of the representation.

Keeping in view the limited prayer of the petitioners and by considering the submissions that similarly situated persons have been regularized and no action has been taken on the representation filed by the

petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to consider the representation dated 2.4.2016 (Annexure P-5) within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

In case, the petitioners are found to be entitled for the relief as sought in the representation and their case is at par with other persons as mentioned above, the necessary action by regularizing their services as well as grant of consequential benefits be taken within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. The petitioners if aggrieved in any manner, are at liberty to avail the appropriate remedy available to them under the law.
