The petitioner had approached this Court on the ground that she had secured 99.019041 percentile in NEET-2016 and in the provisional merit list she had figured at Sr. No. 501 (Annexure P-6), but was not admitted by online process.

Reference had been made to the notice dated 25.09.2016 and the orders dated 27.09.2016 passed by the Apex Court in ***Writ Petition (Civil) No.76 of 2015 'Ashish Ranjan and others Vs. Union of India and others'*** (Annexure R-3/6) where deadline has been extended for seven days from 01.10.2016 to 07.10.2016. Resultantly, direction had been issued, in case the counselling is done for the MBBS course, the petitioner will also be considered.

Counsel for the respondent-University submits that admission for only BDS courses has been done.

In the reply filed by respondent-University, it has been clarified that the cut-off-date for the MBBS was 30.09.2016 and no admission could be made after the cut-off-date. If she had not attended the counselling on the original date alongwith original documents, she cannot take advantage now.

It has further been averred that the Additional Advocate General Haryana had also sought information regarding vacant seats in the State Quota and the Apex Court had also declined to grant permission to State of Haryana to fill up vacant seats of MBBS and there was no counselling after 30.09.2016 even for the 8 vacant seats.

In such circumstances, no relief can be granted to the petitioner for admission in the MBBS Course. Accordingly, the present writ petition is dismissed.
