The instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to take back once used gunny bags, lying with the petitioner for the Kharif Marketing Season (KMS) 2013-14 and current KMS 2014-15, compelled to be retained by the millers at the rate of 60% of the cost and for a direction to the respondents not to recover value of the once used gunny bags, as respondents No.2 to 6 are not allowing the petitioner to use once used gunny bags for procurement of paddy during KMS 2013-14 and current KMS 2014-15, despite being allowed by respondent No.1.

The counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that the issue raised in this petition is squarely covered by a recent judgment

rendered by a Coordinate Bench of this Court in ***CWP No. 5179 of 2014; Kharar Rice Mills, Kharar and others Vs. Union of India and others***; decided on 29.02.2016, involving similar questions of fact and law.

Accordingly, the present petition is also ordered to be disposed of in terms of the judgment rendered in CWP No. 5179 of 2014; Kharar Rice Mills, Kharar and others Vs. Union of India and others; decided on 29.02.2016.
