When the case came up for hearing on 27.07.2016, following order was passed by this Court: -

“Learned counsel for the State seeks time to get instructions whether the application of the petitioner moved in compliance of the order dated 28.07.2015 (Annexure P-4) seeking fresh allotment of the depot would be considered, treating the petitioner as eligible.

On his request, adjourned to 09.11.2016.”

In compliance of the abovesaid order, learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Sunil Grover, Assistant, Department of Food and Supplies, Haryana, Chandigarh submits that competent authority is ready to consider the claim of the petitioner. He further submits that claim of the petitioner shall be considered within a period of six weeks from today, by passing an appropriate order.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the State submits that let the present writ petition be disposed of.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner also fairly states that let the present writ petition be disposed of, in terms of the statement made by learned counsel for the State.

In view of the abovesaid respective fair statements made by learned counsel for the parties, present writ petition is disposed of, with a direction to the competent authority to pass an appropriate order without any further loss of time and in any case within a period of six weeks from today.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, instant writ petition stands disposed of.
