The petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for directing respondents No. 1 to 6 to take action against private respondents No. 7 to 17, who, it is stated, are running 'petha' (winter melon or ash gourd) factories in residential areas without permission from any authority and thereby creating pollution in residential areas in a highly illegal and improper manner. A further prayer has been made for closing the 'petha' (winter melon or ash gourd) factories running in residential areas without any licence or permission.

Learned counsel for the petitioners prays that for the present he may be granted permission to withdraw the writ petition and approach the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Karnal (respondent No.2) by filing a petition in accordance with and under the provisions of the Haryana

Municipal Corporation Act, 1994 claiming similar relief of closing the ‘petha’ (winter melon or ash gourd) factories as these are running without any licence or permission. However, in case, grievances of the petitioners are not redressed, they be granted liberty to approach this Court.

The writ petition is accordingly dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
