JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Petitioner-Charanjit Singh is working as Field Officer, Markfed Branch, Ferozepur and seeking directing for writ in the nature of Certiorari, quashing the complaint made by the office of Markfed to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur regarding insistence of cheating by the petitioner, and, therefore, registration of FIR.

Learned Counsel for the respondent nos.2 & 3-Markfed submits that the present petition has become infructuous, as the FIR stands registered on 23.12.2014 for offences under Section 420, 409, 406 IPC and Section 7 of the Essential Commodities Act.

Learned State Counsel assisted by ASI Kuldeep Singh submits

that after thorough investigation challan has been presented before the learned Illaqa Magistrate on 26.09.2016.

In response, learned Counsel for the petitioner very fairly concedes that in the light of the challan itself having been presented, prayer sought in the present petition has become infructuous.

In view of the above, present petition is hereby dismissed as infructuous.
