Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner shall be satisfied if the petition is disposed of with a direction to the official respondent(s) to decide his representation.

Without making any observations on the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the petition with direction to respondent No.4 to consider and decide the representation dated 29.09.2016 (Annexure P7) within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
