Anupinder Singh Grewal, J. (Oral) :

The petitioner, who was working as NAMP (National Ambient Air Monitoring Programme) Operator with the respondents, is seeking direction to the respondents for payment of his honorarium. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that although the respondents have admitted that an amount of ₹ 1,08,500/- is payable to the petitioner but the same has not been disbursed so far. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he shall be satisfied if the legal notice of the petitioner dated 28.4.2016 (Annexure P-5) is decided by the respondents.

Without making any observations on the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with direction to respondents No.1 and 2 to consider and decide the legal notice of the petitioner dated 28.4.2016 (Annexures P-5), in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
