RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J.

The medical condition of the child who suffers from 100% mental disability does not persuade this Court to stall the transfer his father by court direction when the movement from one school to the other involves only 20 Kms. The nature of the problems faced by the family may be difficult but the problem will remain wherever the posting is.

Therefore, I would not intervene in this matter in exercise of extraordinary writ jurisdiction provided by Article 226 of the Constitution of India which would ordinarily be used to prevent substantial injustice.

The petition stands dismissed.
