The grievance of the petitioner in the present petition is that his seniority number in the tentative seniority list was wrongly mentioned. On consideration of objection filed by the petitioner, the seniority number has been corrected but the benefits have not been granted to the petitioner, whereas, juniors to him have been granted the benefits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has made representations on 18.08.2016 (Annexure P-22) and 29.09.2016 (Annexure P-23) but no action has been taken thereupon so far. He further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, in case, the directions are issued by this Court to decide the pending representations.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and by considering the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the

present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.1 and 2 to consider the representations dated 18.08.2016 (Annexure P-22) and 29.09.2016 (Annexure P-23) moved by the petitioner and pass necessary order in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, the petitioner is found to be entitled for the relief sought for in the representations, the same be granted to him within a period of two months thereafter and in case, the petitioner is still aggrieved in any manner, he is at liberty to approach the appropriate authority.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
