Anupinder Singh Grewal, J. (Oral) :

The petitioner had applied for the post of Assistant Lineman in SC category in pursuance to the advertisement issued by the respondents in the year 2011. It is stated that the petitioner was at Serial No. 50 in the waiting list in SC category. It is case of the petitioner that as the adequate number of candidates in the Ex-servicemen SC category were not available then those posts should have been diverted to the SC main category. If such course had been adopted by the respondents, the petitioner would have been eligible for appointment. He has placed reliance upon a judgment of a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in the case of “**Prem Chand and others v. State of Haryana and others**” CWP No. **17706 of 2013** decided on **18.5.2016**.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has further submitted that he shall be satisfied if the petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide the case of the petitioner in the light of the judgment in the case of **Prem Chand and others v. State of Haryana and others** (supra).

Without making any observations on the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with direction to respondents No.1 and 2 to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner dated 22.8.2016 (Annexures P-11), in view of the judgment in the case of **Prem Chand and others v. State of Haryana and others** (supra) and other relevant material, in accordance with law, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
