When the case was taken up on 20.10.2016, it was called twice but none came present to argue the matter and in the interest of justice, the case was adjourned to today. Similar is the position today. Nobody has come present to argue the matter or even for seeking pass over. Further, there is no legal notice or representation moved by the petitioner, served on the respondents before filing the present writ petition, seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus.

In view of the above, present writ petition is disposed of, with a direction to the petitioner to approach the respondent authorities, at the first instance by moving an appropriate representation or legal notice. It goes without saying that if the petitioner would approach the competent authority by moving an appropriate representation or legal notice, the same shall be considered and decided at an early date, by passing an appropriate order, however, strictly in accordance with law.

Disposed of, accordingly.
