RAKESH KUMAR JAIN, J.

This petition is directed against the order dated 31.3.2016 passed by the Tribunal under the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizen Act, 2007 [for short 'the Act'] awarding ₹5000/- per annum to respondent No.4, mother of the petitioner and order dated 19.8.2016 dismissing the appeal filed by the petitioner under Section 16 of the Act by the Appellate Tribunal.

The mother of the petitioner is a widow. The house in which she is presently staying is owned by her late husband Ram Kumar. She is 65 years of age and staying alone. She made a complaint that the petitioner along with his wife gave her beatings in order to get her house transferred in their name. She has not been given any maintenance by the petitioner though she has no source of income.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has though argued that the petitioner would take care of respondent No.4, provided the order, passed by the Tribunal, upheld by the Appellate Tribunal, directing the petitioner to pay ₹5000/- per month, is withdrawn.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and perusing the record, I am of the considered opinion that there is no substance in this petition much less the argument raised by counsel for the petitioner to interfere in the impugned orders. Consequently, the present petition is denuded of any merit and the same is hereby dismissed.
